OrganizationProfile

The missionary 'Franciscan Sisters of Heart of Mary ' have provided services over 160 years in education and healthcare services for the needy and marginalized. The Sisters have cared for those with family issues and have valued openness, tolerance and acceptance of the other and have applied these practices in their work. The Franciscan Sisters' School – administered by the Sisters, currently provides an education for 591 students from kindergarten to the 10th grade. Their work and dedication to the school has made it one of the best schools in Jericho. The school highly values education and has introduced many new teaching and learning methods introduced in the school in the past few years, which has set the school apart from other schools in Jericho.

ProjectDescription

When a student uses any learning technology, such as a computer, he or she instantly becomes an active learner, in charge of making own choices and decisions. This learning process is a departure from being a passive recipient of information from his teacher. Modern technology in the classroom has also changed the role of the teacher. Traditionally, the teacher has been the focal point in a class; now that role has become more indirect as a coach, mentor or facilitator who observes the process of learning activities around their students. With a generous grant from KHS-Holland in the amount of 5,030 Euros (USD 5,721.890, Sr. Majida Haddad at the Franciscan School in Jericho has purchased and installed new learning technology including two computers, two laptops, five projectors holders, and fourteen projector screens that will facilitate the new teaching methods in the school. The equipment was installed at the classrooms and the school's computer lab with minor electrical work in order to serve the teachers and around 591 school students.
