OrganizationProfile

Pontifical Mission Cultural & Resource Center, Bethlehem has become a refuge and an invaluable resource for all members of society to freely learn and read. It has a collection of over 40,000 volumes of children's and adult books in the local language and other foreign languages. Staff members including members of the Teresian Association, organize and provide educational and recreational activities for all age groups such as the monthly adult inter-religious and intercultural dialogue sessions, children's story-telling, art classes or tutoring in Arabic and English, creative writing and guitar lessons or organizing the annual children's and youth summer camp. The center's members are intrigued by the vast amount of resources and activities available which has attracted schools to organize joint activities with the center.

ProjectDescription

The Pontifical Mission Cultural and Resource Center organizes an annual summer camp program that attracts children and youth from Bethlehem and surrounding areas. The successful program offers creative ways to help children and youth develop and improve themselves. In 2018 for instance, 122 children and youth between grades 1-8, attended the 4-week program (June 18- July 27th, 2018) in three separate groups according to age/school level. Younger children participated in activities related to outdoor games, story-telling and discussion, educational games, dancing and singing, 'values formation activities', art sessions, word scramble, swimming trips and puppet workshops. The 2019 Youth Group summer camp activities included personality development training and workshops that develop leadership skills, creative thinking and decision-making as well as sports, dance, art, guitar lessons, educational games, drama and film-viewing. The generous grant of 6,300 Euros (\$7,166.58) from KHS-Holland covered the costs of the summer camp including speakers and trainers, materials, transportation and field trips, hospitality, T-shirts and caps, and communication costs, benefiting 122 children and youth from the Bethlehem area.
