OrganizationProfile

Maison du Sacre Coeur or 'House of the Sacred Heart' was originally built as a Catholic school run by the Daughters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul but closed and later reopened in 1975 to serve children with special needs. Since then, the Home has gradually been remodeled to suit the needs of its residents -around 40 severely physically and mentally handicapped children aged 3 - 22 years old and from different religious and social backgrounds. The Home provides specialized therapy including physical, speech, music and sensory therapy in addition to residency for the handicapped children. Around 200 children also attend the Home's specialized day care center located in the same compound. Four Daughters of Charity Sisters and 105 professional staff currently operate Maison du Sacre Couer.

ProjectDescription

With a generous donation from KHS- Holland, Maison du Sacre Coeur in Haifa was able to purchase medical supplies and therapeutic equipment for 40 handicapped children who reside at the home. With KHS-Holland funds totaling 11,662 Euros (\$ 12,932.35), Maison du Sacre Couer was able to purchase a large dynamic walker, an electric standing board, a portable oxygen server, one feeding machine, four individual suction machines and two feeding machines. Sr. Katharina Fuchs confirmed that the supplies and equipment will aid special treatment and care for 40 severely handicapped children including those who are autistic and others with special needs.
