OrganizationProfile

The Daughters of Charity opened the Holy Family Children's Home "Creche" in 1905 to serve the needs of the poorest families in Bethlehem. Today, the Creche has 90 children aged 0 - 6 years old, where most are neglected or abused, abandoned babies or illegitimate children. Two thirds of the children are sent by the Palestinian social service office to the Creche. The Sisters of the Creche and other staff members care for the children, providing food, clothing and loving care. The Daughters of Charity also have a Social Service Department that provides financial support for poor families.

ProjectDescription

Besides serving the needs of the children of the Creche, the laundry department provides paid services for the Holy Family Hospital and the St. Vincent Guest house, which helps cover partial running expenses of the operating cost for the Creche. The Sisters who operate the Creche, desperately needed new washing machines to replace the old machines which broke down often and were expensive to fix. Furthermore, the Sisters used local laundromats for the linens which was expensive. To better serve the needs of the children and patients of the hospital, a generous grant of 18,000 Euros (\$20,190.97) from KHS-Holland enabled the hospital to purchase two new washing machines that replaced the old washing machines. This effort ensured that the Creche and hospital had fresh, clean linens available, saving energy, time and money.
