OrganizationProfile

The Greek Orthodox Secondary School in Taybeh was established in 1770 by the Greek Orthodox Patriarchate in what was then part of the Turkish (Ottoman) Empire. However, political unrest throughout the ages have led the small Greek Orthodox school to close its doors many times. Later in the 20th century, the school was re-opened and due to its primary location, it expanded to include a high school. Today, the Greek Orthodox Secondary School remains a Church institution which has a student body of 600 students from Taybeh and the surrounding Palestinian villages in addition to a teaching faculty of 42 teachers.

ProjectDescription

The Palestinian Ministry of Education has already begun introducing modern technology into its education system and has encouraged all Palestinian schools to use Smartboards and other technical devices for classroom lessons and discussions. Greek Orthodox Secondary School in Taybeh which is part of the Palestinian education system is thus obliged to adapt to the new rules and add 4 Smartboards in 4 classrooms. According to school regulations, the school must add new rubber tiles to the floor and portions of the wall in the outdoor playground of the kindergarten to ensure the safety of children. A generous grant from KHS-Holland in the total amount of €9,000 (\$9,980.38) enabled the school to install 4 smart LCDs and install rubber tiles in the playground, benefiting 600 students of the school.
