St. Joseph Girls School, Jerusalem was established in 1848 and aims to provide an education for all of its students, especially since the Palestinian population of East Jerusalem and the Old City are under constant political, economic and social pressure. More importantly, private Christian schools must adhere to the regulations of both the Israeli and Palestinian Ministry of Education which creates additional pressure on the schools. A small subsidy from the Israeli Ministry of Education supports school operating costs however the Palestinian Ministry of Education does not provide a subsidy. Private Christian schools in East Jerusalem are forced to rely on donor contributions to cover school operations, education programs, facility upgrades and other needs every year.

Project Description

The Sisters at St. Joseph Girls School requested assistance to purchase and install several educational devices for classrooms in order to upgrade and incorporate digital media within the curriculum. The Sisters require 4 overhead smart projectors, 8 wireless loudspeaker systems and 4 hard disk & keyboards, amounting to 12,020 Euros which is the total amount requested from KHS-Holland. The proposed project would help around 340 students of the upper grades who study complex subjects. Internet access would enable students to understand the material better and adhere to the requirements of both Ministries of Education which require multimedia use in the classrooms.
