Family Condition:

T and his wife C are living their children, 6-year old T and 2- year old C in a two-bedroom home, with a living room, bathroom, and small kitchen. The home has poor ventilation and a faulty electrical network which risks the health and safety of the entire family.

Medical Condition:

T, his wife, and daughter are healthy, except their 2-year old son C, who recently suffered a brain stroke and is on continuous medical treatment at Hadassah Hospital in Jerusalem. C and their children have the Israeli identity card and are qualified for Israeli medical insurance.

Financial Condition:

T works as an employee at a local mobile phone store, earning 3,000 NIS per month. C used to work in a beauty salon until her son became seriously sick and had to quit her job. She was unable to leave him at home or put him in a day nursery because of his serious condition. T took out a USD15,000 bank loan in order to do some home improvement however more work is needed.

The Family's Need: Roof Isolation and electrical network

The S's family home has a leaky roof which creates several problems. Mold and mildew has built-up throughout the home, especially in the children's bedroom where it is even on the children's beds and toys. There is also serious damage to the electrical network caused by the humidity. In order to enhance the living conditions of the S family home, the proposed project intends to isolate the roof and fix the electrical network. The total estimated cost of work is 4,800 Euros.
